## Reminders for all parents/Carers:

- ❖ All Parents/Carers have a contract with the nursery, we would like to remind you that all parents/Carers need to give 4 WEEKS NOTICE IN WRITING if your child is leaving Bloomers Day Nursery, the notice period will not start until we receive the letter dated.
- ❖ Can all parents/Carers who have been given contracts and not returned them please bring them into the nursery and hand the contract to a staff member, if we don't receive one from you we will ask you to sign another one at the nursery.
- ❖ All parents/Carers are reminded to fold down your prams, including the big ones. If your pram doesn't fold down then you won't be able to leave them at nursery as the space is small and we have loads of children. ALSO no parents are allowed to leave their prams overnight at the nursery in the buggy area, the nursery will not be held responsible for any lost property and we are unable to check CCTV for lost property. ALSO this is a fire exit so please keep it clear.
- ❖ All parents/Carers are reminded that we have 3 INSET days a year for staff training and development, you will be given one month's notice in advance when these inset days will happen.
- ❖ Parents/Carers are asked to come in before 6pm to collect their children/child as the nursery closes at 6pm prompt. Staff have had a long day and would like to go home at 6pm when the nursery closes.
