




SEPTEMBER 2016 NEWSLETTER

Curriculum at Bloomers Day Nursery.

- ❖ The pre-School children are learning how to form their names on the magnetic boards using the magnetic letters.
- ❖ Toddlers are learning communication skills through circle time sessions twice a day and through language groups twice a day.

Important Notes for parents and carers.

- ❖ All medication taken from parents at Bloomers Day Nursery needs to be prescribed by a doctor with your child's name clearly labeled on it.
- ❖ Baby room parents are allowed to give calpol and teething powders to the staff for their babies teething, but any other medication needs to be prescribed.
- ❖ One months' notice in writing is required when your child is leaving the nursery and also when wanting to change your child's days.
- ❖ Five days' notice in writing is required when requesting for a statement of fees or any other letter to tax credits or employers.
- ❖ All children who pay for school lunch are now required to pay in advance and to the office, staff will no longer be taking money from any parent. All parents are to provide the exact change for lunch fees.
- ❖ Our autumn term 2016 action plan is on the notice board in reception area and also outside pre-School room.
- ❖ There is "walk in, talk in" sessions at Daubeny Children's Centre the first Wednesday of each month 9:30am-11am
- ❖ Breakfast for Toddler children and Pre-School children will now be served in the toddler room.
- ❖ ALL PARENTS/CARERS to please fold down your child's pram in the buggy area, as this area is becoming busy and it's a fire exit, if your pram can not fold you cannot leave it at nursery.
- ❖ Our complaints policy is on the main notice board in the reception area. If any parent/carers should have cause for complaint or any queries regarding the care or learning provided by the nursery please feel free to discuss with the nursery management team.
