What we have been learning! 😊

Our blossoming Pre-School children have been learning about people and the jobs they do through understanding of the world. They are currently taking part in role playing 'Doctors' and learning about their important jobs! The Pre-School children are enjoying learning about this through role play and enjoy taking part in some of the daily things doctors and nurses do such as putting on bandages for people. As well as children experience through their role playing, they are also enjoying looking and reading books they collected from the local library.



Pre-School children are also taking part in junk modelling activities where they can express their imagination through making models of their choice, for example some children have said they have made cars, bikes, houses and so on.



At Bloomers we are teaching and following a healthy eating programme where children are learning about staying healthy and learning what foods are good for them and what isn't. Pre-School children have taken part in activities where they have made their own picture lunch boxes of what food they think is good for them, they also have a healthy eating display in their room showing them every day good foods and everyday bad foods.



Toddler room have been learning a new story of the month- The Very Hungry Caterpillar, they have been learning about how things grow and change such as it starts from an egg, forms into a caterpillar and then into a bright colourful butterfly. Toddlers have been doing activities based on this story such as making their own caterpillar story books, making caterpillar pictures and also looking for butterflies outside in the garden area. Toddler room have also implemented a nursery rhyme that supports learning about caterpillars.



Toddler room have been learning about numbers in the environment of their room, looking for shapes and sizes through their play, they have been taking part in completing number and shape puzzles, counting through tidy up time and also singing number songs. Toddler room have now implemented numbers and counting in other activities as well as maths to support learning and development, they now have playdough mats out when playing with playdough to encourage them to learn numbers through fun activities.



We have also been learning about celebrations throughout the year and teaching children about different festivals and the importance of them. Children have all taken part in making Fathers day Cards for their dads and also created displays.
