### Please Note:

- ✚ All solely funded hours from September 2018 will be from 9:30am- 3pm, this is to ensure that all key parents/carers are seeing their children's key person daily and to ensure adequate staffing ratio at all times. Staff will contact you over this summer holidays to confirm days and times with you. Also solely funded hours is 38 weeks of the year.
- ✚ Can all parents/ Carers on the 30 hours childcare please remember to re confirm their eligibility and also re apply latest by 31<sup>st</sup> of august 2018, please note that any application after the 31/08/18 will not be valid.
- ✚ Can all parents/Carers ensure that their child has enough spare clothes throughout the day as they play with messy play and water activities and also your child might have an accident while toilet training. Please ensure that you provide enough nappies and wipes for your children.
- ✚ Parents/Carers if you have any old cultural clothes that no longer fits your child/children please can you donate them to the nursery. (ONLY CULTURAL CLOTHES)
- ✚ This is a reminder that weekly fees are due each Monday, Parents/Carers that pay monthly, payment is due on the first working day of each month in advance. In accordance with the nursery fee policy, any child with outstanding fees on their account will be unable to return to the nursery until the outstanding balance is paid.
- ✚ During half term holidays we normally take the Toddlers and Pre-School children out to visit places of interest and also educational visits such as the library, the park, fire station, the farm, museums, B&Q and also Tesco. Currently because the weather has been too hot we have been unable to take the children out, but when the weather becomes cooler we will plan trips to take them out and you will be informed.
